GOVERNANCE & MANAGEMENT

The College is governed by a Board of Governors (BOG) and an Executive Committee (EC). The BOG is chaired by Honorable Governor of Balochistan. Members of the BOG include Minister for Education, Chief Secretary Government of Balochistan, Secretary Colleges Higher & Technical Education, Secretary Law, Secretary S & GAD, Secretary Finance and representative of Additional Chief Secretary. Executive Committee (EC) is chaired by Secretary Colleges, Higher and Technical Education. Members of the EC are Secretary Law, Secretary S & GAD, Secretary Finance, Additional Secretary Colleges Higher & Technical Education and Principals of all cadet colleges. Both meetings of BOG and EC are conducted twice a year to address the challenges in financial, technical and administrative domains and to take necessary steps for smooth functioning of the colleges.

Principal, Cadet College Pishin, has been entrusted and authorized administrative and financial powers to ensure functioning of day to day routine activities pertaining to academic and administrative issues.

Purpose of these tiers of management is to support and ensure the quality education to the selected students at SSC and HSSC levels with a view to achieve academic excellence, improve social behaviour, focus personality development, acquire character traits, impart religious education, ethical values and leadership qualities.

GENESIS

In the pursuance of the Government of Balochistan's decision to expand quality education and institutions across Province, Cadet College Pishin was established in 2007 and the first intake was inducted in the year 2008. The college has been allocated with sufficient land for different purposes and now completely functional with admin and academic activities. Colleges, Higher and Technical Education Department has been closely working and extending its continuous support in financial and technical matters.



Since its inception, three Hostels, Mess, Dispensary, Cafeteria, Mosque, Admin and Academic Blocks, Teachers' Residences, Watch Towers and Security Wall have been constructed. The college is growing and developing every year while new structures are near completion as per Master Plan. So far, Sixteen (16) entries of cadets have been inducted. Passed out cadets have achieved remarkable milestones in practical life by joining Armed Forces, Medical and Engineering fields. They have also got admission in other professional universities in pursuance of higher education.



ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Cadet College Pishin is following and implementing National Educational Policies, Procedures and Plans to synchronize objectives with national commitment. Textbooks and Courses based on Balochistan Text Book Board are being followed in classes. Teachers have complete command on subject contents, pedagogical knowledge and classroom management.

COURSES OFFERED: Pre-Medical and Pre-Engineering subjects are offered during F. Sc.

ASSESSMENTS

FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT: College administration is regularly conducting formative assessment during the academic year. It allows teachers and Cadets to review their performance in Term Exams.

SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT: This assessment is conducted at the end of the academic year with an aim to assess the students learning outcomes and conceptual understanding. Cadets appear in summative assessment and qualify for next grade. This assessment provides a complete picture and evaluation of cadets' as well as teachers' overall academic performance.

SEND-UP EXAMINATION (SSC/HSSC): Cadets need to pass the Examination specially conducted for the purpose of sending admission forms for Board Examination. In case of failure, the admission forms are withheld.





ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

LIBRARY: Library with hundreds of reference books, science and arts books are available to promote reading culture amongst cadets. They are required to spend time for reading in library and enhance their mental capacity while seeking knowledge.

SCIENCE LABORATORIES: CCPN has three well equipped science laboratories (Biology, Chemistry & Physics) with necessary equipments, salts, and apparatus where cadets carry out practical of relevant subjects on regular basis.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY LABORATORY: Information Technology is given due consideration in academic course CCPN has well established IT Lab with qualified IT Instructor to take IT classes. Cadets are given orientation on IT needs and its importance in professional life during the present era.

ONLINE SPOKEN ENGLISH COURSE: English plays a significant role in the present modern world. As its importance is believed internationally, CCPN organizes Online Spoken English Courses for cadets to enhance their competence in English. ELT Specialists are hired from mainstream institutions of Pakistan. Modern teaching techniques and communicative approach is followed during online sessions which enable cadets to improve all the four skills of English Language especially "Listening" and "Speaking".

e-COMMERCE COURSES: e-Commerce courses teaches business management and marketing strategy skills which are key to operate an online business successfully. Its importance is believed unanimously throughout the globe and thus CCPN has arranged online e-Commerce courses for cadets. Competent and professional instructors are hired from the recognized institution of the country for this purpose. This would enable cadets to utilize the new age skills in their everyday life to attain maximum output.

EXTERNAL EXAMS: Balochistan Assessment and Examination Commission conducts Annual Examination for class 8th each year in November. Whereas, Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Quetta, Balochistan is responsible to hold Annual Examination for grade 9th, 10th, 1st and 2nd Year. Extra Coaching & Winter Camp / Preparation Sessions including Intensive Test Series (ITS) are planned and conducted each year to prepare cadets before appearing in the external examination. This endeavor supports cadets to attain success by scoring highest marks.

GUEST SPEAKER: Prominent figures from all walks of life are invited to interact with cadets in order to share their experiences and guide the new generation. This also motivates cadets to follow the footsteps of the successful people in different fields.





EXTRA & CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Improvement of physical fitness and outlook of cadets is given special emphasis. Teams of dedicated physical training instructors and drill instructors from Pakistan Army are entrusted with the responsibilities in the college to impart physical training. Extra and Co-curricular activities are mandatory in overall grooming of cadets and the college pays special attention towards these activities.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES: The college has sports facilities for all the major games like Cricket, Football, Table Tennis, Badminton, Volleyball and Athletics. It is mandatory for each cadet to participate in these games. Additionally, the college is in the process of developing Basket Ball, Tennis, Squash, Gymnasium & Riding Club facilities. Annual competitions at inter and intra cadet college levels are arranged to inculcate sense of a healthy competition among cadets. Sports Fixtures with renowned institutions of Pakistan like Army Burnhall College Abbotabad, Lawrence College Ghora Gali and Military College Murre etc. are also organized to broaden their exposure and to promote learning through competition culture.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES: In order to develop an utmost self-confidence and healthy sense of competition among cadets, Debates in English and Urdu, General Knowledge Competition, English & Urdu Essay Writing Competitions, Geographical and Science Quiz, Spelling-Bee, Naat, Hamd and Qiraat Contests are held regularly at Intra and Inter House levels. In fact, Inter House competitions in all fields are the deciding factor towards the Annual Champions Trophy.





EXTRA & CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

EXPOSURE VISITS / FIELD TRIPS: Apart from Academic, Extra and Co-curricular Activities, Picnics and Field Trips to different places are arranged for all classes for entertainment and to widen their educational spectrum. HSSC cadets (2nd Year Class) are provided opportunity to visit other cities and leading institutions like NUST, NUTECH, PMA etc. for exposure and broaden their horizon.

CELEBRATIONS

ANNUAL PARENTS' DAY: Parents' Day has a unique significance for cadets, teachers and parents and thus organized on annual basis. It provides parents with an opportunity to witness themselves the living conditions, performance and achievements of their sons / wards. The college, therefore, holds Parents' Day every year and the function includes presentation of the Annual Report, Awards of Honour to Cadets, Display of March Past, P.T, Karate, Gymnastic, Tent-Pegging Shows and finally Distribution of Prizes to cadets and staff by the Chief Guest.

MISCELLANEOUS: Cadets are engaged to participate in national and cultural celebrations. Independence Day, Defense Day, Cultural Day and others are celebrated with an aim to promote nationalism, cultural values, traditions and customs of the country. Days of national, religious and cultural importance are celebrated with zeal and fervour.





HOUSE SYSTEM

Cadet College Pishin is a fully residential institution. Thus cadets have to live in the hostels. Cadets of 7th & 8th class are accommodated in Sher Shah House (Junior House) separately. After qualifying 8th grade, they are shifted to four senior houses (Omar, Haider, Jinnah & Iqbal).

Each House is supervised by a House Master (HM) assisted by an Assistant House Master (AHM). Best cadets of 2nd Year class are given various appointments in order to polish their leadership traits. These appointments include:

- ❖ College Prefect
- ❖ Assistant College Prefect
- ❖ House Prefect (each House)
- ❖ College Mess Secretary
- ❖ College Sports Secretary
- ❖ Assistant House Prefect (each House)

College Prefect is the senior most cadet appointment in the college followed by Assistant College Prefect and House Prefects for each House. They organize House activities, ensure discipline and prepare their Houses for Inter House Competitions.

Each House has an Ante Room, wherein, cadets relax, enjoy and watch TV programmes. Indoor games like Scrabble, Luddu, Carom Board, Hand Soccer, Table Tennis, Chess etc. are also provided in Ante Rooms.





CADETS' FACILITATION

CADETS' MESS: Cadets' Mess has the capacity of about 400 cadets which is supervised by College Mess Committee further assisted by a Messing Officer with other staff. It also includes College Mess Secretary (cadet) and Food Members (cadets) and prepares Mess Menu periodically. It is assured that food should include all nutritional ingredients that will supplement and guarantee cadets' health and growth. To ensure the equality of food cooked in mess, it is regularly supervised and monitored by Medical Staff and College Mess Committee and no negligence is tolerated in this regard.

SECURITY: An elaborate security apparatus supervised by Adjutant is in place comprising of trained security staff (FC, Police, Levies & College Security Guards). The college security staff has modern weapons and equipped with all essential security related infrastructure i.e. CCTV Cameras, Communication Equipments and Watch Towers.





CADETS' FACILITATION

MEDICAL FACILITIES: The college has its own Dispensary which is meant to look after health of cadets by a doctor and allied staff. Periodic medical of cadets is conducted after every six months. General treatment is provided in Dispensary however, if required, cadets are referred to concerned specialists at DHQ Hospital, Pishin for further treatment. In case of medical treatment by private specialist, the expenses (if more than Rs. 2000/-) for such consultation / treatment are borne by parents.

ACCIDENTS / MISHAPS: The college adopts all possible measures for the safety of cadets during their stay in the campus. However, the college shall not be held responsible for any kind of accidents / mishaps causing any physical harm and injury during various activities inside or outside the college.





CADETS' FACILITATION

COLLEGE MOSQUE: To inculcate Islamic values, cadets are bound to offer five time prayers in Mosque with religious spirit. Pesh Imam and Moazin are responsible to supervise prayers and Tilawat-e-Quran Pak. House Master and Assistant House Master regularly observe and ensure cadets offering five time prayers in Mosque. Talim-ul-Quran Pak (Nazra) is mandatory for cadets of class 7th & 8th and they have to attend these sessions in Mosque during prescribed timings (as per Daily Routine). Talim-ul-Quran Pak (Nazra) of cadets of 7th & 8th class is evaluated at the end of each academic year.

AMENITY BLOCK: In order to facilitate cadets, the college provides them a conducive environment thus, an Amenity Block has also been set up within the college premises including Barber Shop, Cobbler Shop, Tailor Shop, General Store and Cafeteria. Cadets visit the market area during prescribed timings where quality items are provided on affordable prices.





ADMISSION & SELECTION PROCEDURE

ADMISSION: The admission process starts from 1st week of November each year. Advertisement regarding admission is published in national newspapers. Application Forms (attached with Prospectus and can be downloaded from the college website), complete in all aspects, are to be submitted on or before the last date mentioned in the advertisement. On receipt, the forms are scrutinized and candidates found eligible are issued Roll Numbers. Written Test is conducted on date which is advertised in newspapers and the same is also intimated to individuals.

ELIGIBILITY: Candidates must have passed Class – VI Examination from a recognized school by March of year of Admission.

AGE: Age limit is 11 to 13 years as on March, 31st in the year of Admission (not even a single day less or above).

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- ❖ Total 70 seats are allocated as per devised distribution for each District of Balochistan and other provinces of Pakistan.
- ❖ 10% home division quota approved by BOG. (Quetta Division including Quetta, Pishin, Killa Abdullah & Chaman Districts)
- ❖ 1x seat is allocated for each province (KPK, Punjab, Sindh) and 1x seat for Capital Territory Islamabad/AJK/ Gilgit Baltistan.
- ❖ In case the seat of particular district remains vacant, then it is allocated to the parent division. If still unfilled then the vacancy is placed on open merit for the whole province (Balochistan).
- ❖ Top merit candidates from each district / province as per respective quota are called for Intelligence Test and Interview. Interview Panel is constituted for the selection of cadets under the Chairmanship of Principal and includes Vice Principal, Psychologist, HOD English, HOD Math & HOD Science as members. The selection is made on the basis of obtained marks (40 passing marks) in Written Test, Intelligence Test and Interview.
- ❖ Selected candidates based on results and Interview marks are asked to appear in medical and required to obtain fitness certificate from concerned CMH (medical includes X-Ray Chest, HIV, HBS Ag, HCV, Blood CP, Urined/R and Eye test).
- ❖ Written Test is given weightage of 70% marks while Intelligence Test and Interview are of 30%.
- ❖ In case selected candidate on merit becomes unwilling to report or withdraw his seat from the merit list, then the next candidate on the waiting list is called as per merit.
- ❖ Those who qualify all stages are placed on a merit list for final selection.
- ❖ As per merit, final call-up letters for joining are then issued and the selected are to join by a date indicated (normally end of March).
- ❖ Change of address or telephone numbers, if any, must be intimated to the college immediately.
- ❖ The college admits no liability for delay / no-delivery or loss of the communication due to postal system.

RE-ADMISSION IN 1ST YEAR: SOP's (Standing Operating Procedures) for re-admission in 1st Year class will be as under:

- Matric class cadets, after the Board Examination, will return to their homes after clearance.
- After the announcement of Matric results, 1st Year admissions forms will be sent to those who have passed Matric Examination from Cadet College Pishin. The admissions in 1st Year will be given to cadets securing 60% marks in Matric Exam along with acceptable conduct and track record from 7th to 10th class during his stay at the college.



RULES & REGULATIONS

Discipline has always been backbone of any cadet college thus Rules and Regulations are strictly observed at CCPN. Cadets found guilty of any breach are liable to be expelled or would be charged a fine from Rs. 500/- to Rs. 10000/- for each category of offence. However, frequent display of "poor – discipline" and "poor – performance in academics" may lead to permanent expulsion from the college as per the college Rules & Regulations. The College Discipline Committee is entitled to recommend expulsion from the college or fine for certain breaches of discipline if it deems necessary. If a cadet gets married during his stay in the college, his admission will stand cancelled.

FOLLOWING ARE STRICTLY FORBIDDEN:-

- ❖ Bringing Smart Phones, Camera Phones, Expensive Watches, Rings Etc.
- ❖ Bringing pets, Recording gadget, Radio, Video Games, Cards, Electric Heaters, TV, Dish Antenna, Wireless set, Camera, CDs Etc.
- ❖ Disfiguring or defacing the college property.
- ❖ Lending or borrowing money, betting, gambling and lotteries Etc.
- ❖ Using unfair means in Examination and tests.
- ❖ Stealing and indulgence in immoral activities.
- ❖ Misbehaving with staff.
- ❖ Fighting amongst each other and manhandling.
- ❖ Smoking / using drugs or unauthorized medicines Etc.
- ❖ Activities which caused disaffection or discontentment among others.
- ❖ Keeping firearms, knives or weapons of any sort.
- ❖ Being absent from the class or other activities.
- ❖ Bad expression in words or deeds, disliking for the college, its property or Rules & Regulations.
- ❖ Refusal to pay the college fees / fines or any other dues.
- ❖ Visiting Amenity Block (Barber Shop, General Store, Cafeteria Etc.) during unauthorized timings.
- ❖ Roaming in prohibited areas, residential areas, outside the college boundary.





MISCELLANEOUS

PARENTS TEACHERS MEETING: Parents Teachers Meeting is an effective forum, therein, parents and teachers are given opportunity to interact with each other and discuss cadets' performance including Academic and Discipline aspects to satisfy each other about their overall grooming. Face-to-face communication, undoubtedly, helps both parents and teachers to suggest and recommend for further improvement of cadets. Thus, PTM is held after each internal examination (Terms) in which parents are briefed regarding their sons' / wards' standing in education, grooming and discipline at the college.

CADETS' COUNSELLING: Counselling is an important input for overall grooming of cadets and helps them eradicate numerous problems confronted during practical life. Trained teachers are always available, along with Guest Speakers, to provide needed counselling to cadets on different issues / matters with the purpose to remove impediments found in psychological and academic domains.

LEAVE: Leave, other than the gazetted holidays, will not be granted except in exceptional circumstances of genuine nature. No leave will be granted for attending weddings, except the weddings of real brothers and sisters.

EXTRA MONEY: Cadets are not allowed to keep any extra money with them. Parents may deposit extra money to concerned House Master who keeps the record and gives it to cadets as and when they need. If any cash more than Rs. 2000/- is found with a cadet, the amount will be confiscated.

TELEPHONE: Cadets are permitted to contact their parents on telephone on every **Sunday** from **1000 to 1700 hours**. Cadets may deposit expensive mobile phones (without camera) with their respective House Master and can communicate with families and friends on Sunday. For this purpose, Official Telephones are also available in all Houses to facilitate cadets in communicating with their parents during the stated hours on Sunday.
